Memorandum of Understanding between the Parks Australia Division and the Heritage Division

1.0 Purpose

1.1 This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) defines the arrangements for Australian National Botanic Gardens (ANBG) to handover non-plant and non-vegetation images inherited from the Australian National Parks and Wildlife Service (ANPWS) listed in Schedule 1 to the Australian Heritage photo Library (AHPL) which is currently located in the Heritage Division (HD).

1.2 It is recognised that the:

- ANBG is responsible for the management of plant and vegetation images and other images and audiovisual material related to the history and natural history of botanic gardens as set out in the ANBG Management Plan 2002-2008 Sect. 5.4 and that these will continue to be held at the ANBG.
- HD is currently responsible for the management of the Department of the Environment and Heritage (DEH) photographic and audiovisual collections.
- Ongoing collaboration and cooperation will be required between the Divisions to ensure a high quality service is provided to all stakeholders.
- Copyright of the ex-ANPWS images is held by the Director of National Parks under a deed made with the Commonwealth on 23 December 1993.
- This MoU will be unaffected by any future changes to the management arrangements for the AHPL within the Department.

2.0 Timeframe

2.1 This MoU will be effective from the endorsement date by both Divisions.

3.0 Contact areas and personnel

- 3.1 At the Director level the primary points of contact will be the Director of ANBG, Parks Australia South and the Director of Heritage Information Section, Heritage Strategy Branch.
- 3.2 At the operational level, the primary points of contact for HD will be Mark Mohell (02 6274 2076) and for ANBG will be Murray Fagg (02 6250 9530).

4.0. Heritage Division

4.1 HD will take responsibility for maintaining, managing, digitisation and storage of the ex-ANPWS non-plant and non-vegetation images listed in Schedule 1 to archival standards in the John Gorton Building (JGB).







- 4.2 HD will consult with the ANBG regarding photographic services and related activities that involve the use of the non-plant and non-vegetation images that are being handed over.
- 4.3 HD will respond to and service all requests for ANBG non-plant and non-vegetation images, both from within DEH and externally.

5.0. Australian National Botanic Gardens

- 5.1 ANBG will hand over control of all non-plant and non-vegetation images inherited from the Australian National Parks and Wildlife Service listed in Schedule 1 to HD, for addition to the DEH Photographic Collection.
- 5.2 ANBG will consult with the HD regarding photographic services and related activities to the ANBG.

6.0. Resources

6.1 No exchange of resources is required from endorsement under this MoU.
